



- We are new to Cheerleading and Dance and I/my child has no experience. Will they make a competitive team?
- Yes, our semi-competitive program is perfect for beginners wanting to start in competitive Cheer and Dance!
- How do I know what Team Assessment Classes to attend? After completing a 2026 Registration Form Perth Magic staff will advise you via email of when your child will be assessed across one/multiple of their current training classes OR which additional classes they will be required to attend to complete their assessment.
  - I do not have all the required skills for a particular team, but would still like to be considered for a place in the team. Coaches will consider athletes for all teams they select in their registration form. Please note limited positions are available on teams for athletes without all required skills.
- Why is there a Team Placement Fee? Our \$30 Team Placement Fee covers our Coaches for additional hours through Assessment Week and our Athlete Placement Meetings, where we finalise all competitive team placements.
- How do I make payment for my Team Placement Fee? Upon completing your online registration, you will have access to the online Magic Portal, following a confirmation email from our staff. Payment can be made via your Magic Portal or by EFT/CASH at the gym.
- What do I do if I cannot attend any classes during Team Assessment Week? Complete your online registration and select the box to let us know you cannot make it to the gym during Team Assessment Week. Our staff will contact you to arrange an alternate date to assess your/your child's Cheer and Dance skills. Please note the Team Placement Fee is still due, to cover our coach's wages for the entire Team Assessment process.
- I've completed a year in a particular level, does that mean I 'move up' to the next level? Only if you can confidently and correctly perform the required tumbling and stunting skills for the next level. Athletes usually spend multiple years in each level, as outlined on page 3 of this Information Pack.
- My child has the required tumbling skills for the next level, does this mean my child will move up a level? Not necessarily athletes are required to show competence in all areas of Cheer. This includes tumbling, stunting, jumps, choreography and performance, along with qualities of teamwork and good work ethic. Coaches take into account every athlete's overall performance and mental readiness when creating teams.
- How do you choose teams? We take great care in the placement of each and every individual athlete at PERTH MAGIC. Our experienced Senior Coaches work closely throughout the Team Placement Process to discuss each athlete's suitability to compete with confidence, train skills safely and grow in the most appropriate team for them. Coaches take into account each athlete's performance during Team Assessment Week and the entire 2025 season in training and at events. Coaches spend time in multiple placement meetings carefully considering placements to ensure every single athlete is placed onto the best team for them.
- What do I do if I am unhappy with my team offer? Before contacting us, please take into consideration the team placement guidelines and team requirements and know that your child's best interest has been taken into consideration when placing them on their team - can your child complete all required skills repeatedly with confidence and good technique and did they show strong work ethic, commitment and great attitude in training throughout 2025? Team placements are multifaceted and we believe the team each individual receives is where they will thrive the best for the 2026 season. If you are still unhappy about your team offer after 48 hours, our coaches will happily discuss with you the reasons behind your/your child's placement. Please note all team placements are final.
- How will I know if I/my child is a flyer? In your 2026 Offer email we will outline if you/your child is being considered for a position as a flyer on their 2026 team. Flying positions are never permanent and are subject to change due to an athlete's ability to perform at the appropriate level and suitability for the entire team's stunting dynamics. To be eligible for a flyer position on an All Star Team, athletes must attend their allocated 15 minute Flight Stretch Class each week and commit to their individual progress at the gym and at home throughout the season. Flight Stretch Class schedules will be included in 2026 Offer emails. All Full-Competitive Team athletes are welcome to attend a 15 minute Flight Stretch Class at no additional cost each week.
- When will TOURING TEAMS be announced? Coaches take into consideration the number of families wishing to tour in 2026. We believe in giving all committed athletes the opportunity to tour Nationally and endeavour to take a variety of age groups and levels. This means we could select any teams from our Full-Competitive program to attend Nationals! Touring Teams will be announced and communicated to families in their Letter of Offer via email in December.
- Are there multiple payment options for tuition/camp/competition/uniform fees? PERTH MAGIC offers multiple payment options for Novice/All Star teams as outlined on page 8 - we are introducing weekly and fortnightly payment options in addition to monthly tuition payment schedules in 2026. Please note athletes will not be registered for events, booked into camps or have uniform items ordered for them until invoices are paid in full. For further information please refer to our Payment Policies on our website.
- Will the competition uniform remain the same for 2026? Our Full-Competitive CHEER club uniform will remain the same for the 2026 season (updating in 2027). ALL Cheer teams will receive new BOWS/SCRUNCHIES in 2026. Semi-Competitive and Full-Competitive DANCE teams will receive a NEW dance costume to match their 2026 routines (costuming is a scored item on all dance scorecards so we are required to update these each season to suit the team's choreography/music/themes). Semi-Competitive CHEER teams will be using the current Novice uniform with new poms/bows in 2026.
- Will there be new training merchandise in 2026? Oh yeah! We will periodically drop seasonal merchandise throughout the season!
- Is there are a required training uniform at the gym? All athletes will receive our NEW 2026 Club T-shirt with their enrolment pack. This shirt will be the only required training uniform item at particular training events, camps and/or choreography - this will be communicated via BAND by Coaches prior to each event. We ask athletes to wear appropriate training attire and rock the BLACK, PINK and BLUE as much as they can at the gym!

Cheerleading teaches the athletes to respect each other's differences as all are just as vital as one another in the team. It teaches them about persistence, resilience, teamwork, commitment, endurance and how to accept both winning and losing with grace. After many years as a volunteer Mentor to younger athletes, Meg is about to begin her journey as a coach, and we can think of no better place for her to do this than at Perth Magic All Stars.
